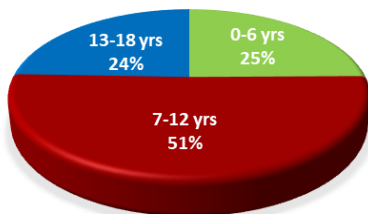

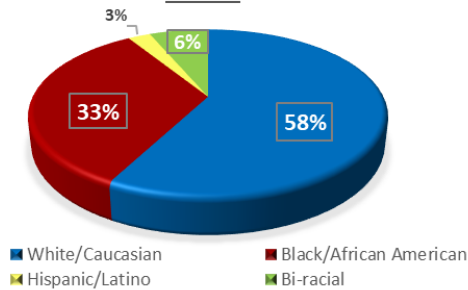

DEMOGRAPHICS

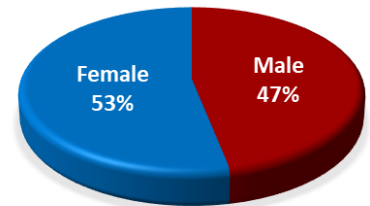
AGE OF CHILD



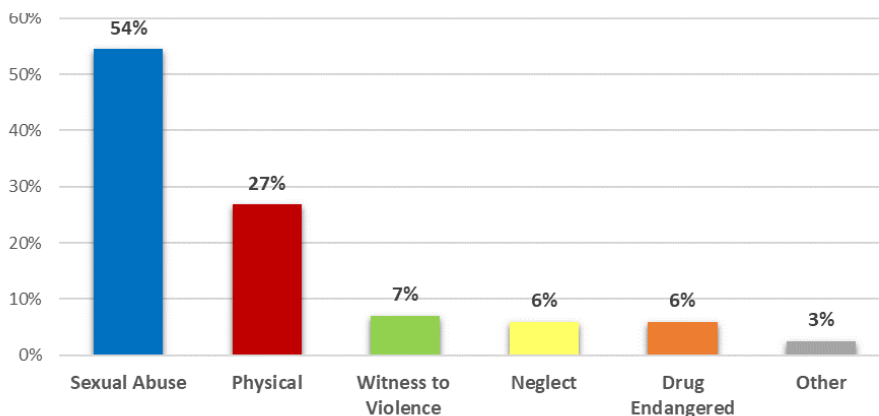
RACE



GENDER

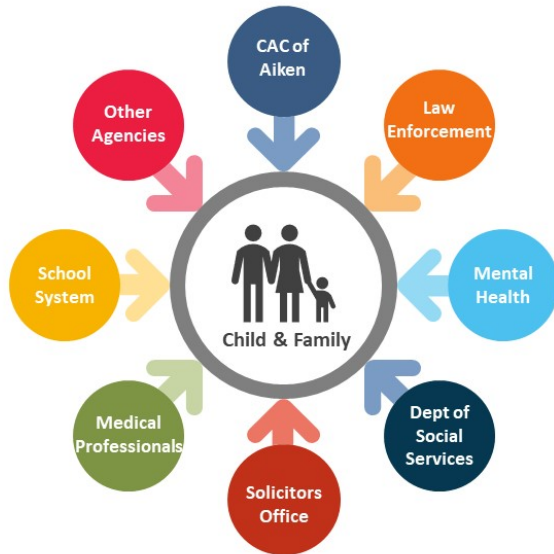


TYPE OF ABUSE



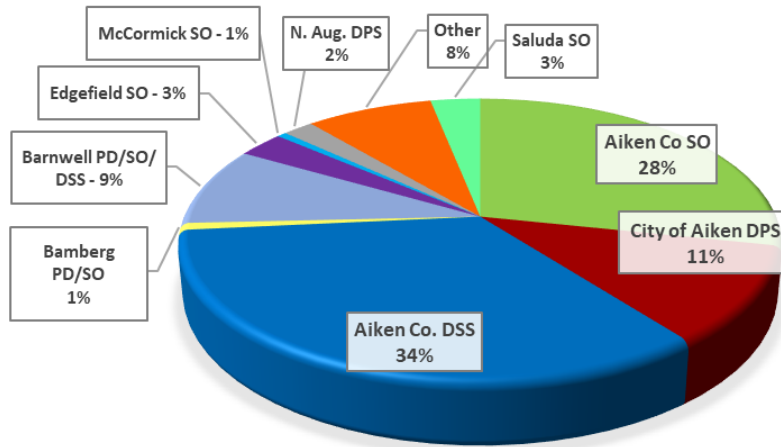
90% of child victims knew their perpetrator
